

# paper Tulips

## Material & Items Needed

- Medium weight colored paper
- Double-sided tape
- Cloth covered floral wire
- Craft glue
- Paper scissors

1. Cut out square piece of colored paper 5 x 5 inches for the tulip. Fold in half, open and then fold in half again. Unfold
2. Apply double sided tape along each of the creases as shown on template. Pinch creases so each piece of tape adheres and paper pops up into a cupped shape.
3. With paper scissors, cut edges of square corners to round the bottom of the tulip.
4. Fold over the tip of the wire and add a dab of glue to the bent wire.
5. Insert the unfolded wire end into the tulip, poking the wire out the bottom of the flower.
6. Place leaf template on a folded piece of green paper. Place the edge where indicated on the fold.
7. Write a short note on leaf (optional). Open up leaf and add glue to the inside folded area. Apply the leaf where desired on stem.
8. Add multiple flowers to a vase, or give the tulip as a single gift. This make fun place setting name tags.
